Dear GLAS Participant,

You applied for the Low-emission Slurry Spreading (LESS) action as part of your application for the Green, Low-carbon, Agri-environment Scheme (GLAS).

Enclosed is your annual declaration and claim form, which must now be completed, in order to process your 2020 payment. The fully completed claim form must be returned by Friday 30th October 2020, to GLAS, Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine, Johnstown Castle Estate, Wexford, Y35 PN52. Your 2020 GLAS payment cannot be processed until this form is returned and approved for payment. ***Failure to return this form may result in you becoming ineligible for payment for the Low-emission Slurry Spreading action and/or the Scheme itself.*** Please note that payment will not issue or may be delayed if all relevant fields are not completed & if a Record 3 form (*if applicable*) has not been returned.

You are not required to enclose receipts with this form. They must be kept by you with your record sheets and be made available for any inspection. To be eligible for payment for LESS, the minimum volume of slurry to be applied annually is 50m³. For ease of calculation, 1m³ is equal to 1,000 litres (220 gallons).

A copy of the relevant record of movement of organic fertilisers form (Record 3 or equivalent form) **MUST** be attached to this application, where slurry is ***imported*** onto the holding.
