Procedures for inclusion in accepted list for
S.132A - Accepted contractors for Geo-membrane lined out-wintering pads.

Any company wishing to become accepted for the construction of Geo-membrane lined out-wintering pads must provide the following information to the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food.

Details required:

1. Product(s) to be supplied.
2. Company Name.
3. Company address.
4. Contact name and telephone number.
5. ISO 9001 certification for liner manufacturer.
6. Details of lining material, including independent product testing reports.
7. Sample of lining material.
8. Details of how leak testing performed on insitu liner for completion of certificate.
9. Guarantee given with the product.
10. Expected lifetime of the product.
11. Declaration that product will only be supplied and fitted to this standard.
12. Confirmation of having read S.132 and agreement to install to this standard as a minimum.

Note: This acceptance will last for 5 years, after a period of 5 years on the list, it will be required for companies to under go a renewal process which will include the resubmission of the above data and evidence of having remained certified to the relevant standards for the previous 5 years and evidence of having produced the product to the agreed standard.

Note: Under S.I. 101 of 2009 it is a legal requirement that **all** out-wintering pads be constructed in accordance with the relevant Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food specification.
